Literacy

This term we will:

- ✓ P3/4 will be looking at a variety of fiction and non-fiction transport and travel/journey books and complete literacy writing activities based around these topics, such as writing journals and creative writing.
- ✓ They will begin to use more descriptive language to describe nouns and verbs and consolidate their use of full stops, question marks and exclamation marks, with P4 beginning to use speech/quotation marks.
- ✓ P3/4 will continue to revise spellings using multi-sensory activities and look at the extended and polysyllabic code using the Sounds Write Phonics Programme.
- ✓ P3/4 have now all been given their Accelerated Reading logins and are developing their comprehension skills while trying to earn rewards for scoring 100% in their tests.

Our Topic this term is Transport & Travel.

We will be learning about...

- ★ *Types of transport.*
- ★ *Journeys we've travelled.*
- ★ *The history of different modes of transport.*
- ★ *Space travel*
- ★ *Transport of the future.*
- ★ *We also hope to visit JB Barrett Tractors!*

And much more.

Numeracy

We are superb Mathematicians in P3 and P4.

This term we will...

- ★ P3 will be focussing on column addition and subtraction, while continuing to learn mental maths facts, such as; adding 9, 19, and 11 or subtracting 9 or 11.
- ★ P3/4 will continue with maths problem solving, while also linking their topic work to maths by carrying out traffic surveys and converting tally/frequency charts into bar charts.
- ★ P4 will be consolidating their column addition and subtraction facts and try to recognise key vocabulary to solve +/- word problems.
- ★ We will also begin to explore fractions.

In ICT we will be developing our word processing skills using Microsoft Word. We will also be using Literacy and Maths Apps such as; Times Tables Rock Stars, Mathletics & Accelerated Reading.

ART

We will be completing art activities linked with our topic of travel and journeys.

In **Religion** we will continue to listen to bible stories, learn about different saints, religious traditions and religious days using the Grow in Love scheme. P4 will continue to prepare for their confession and communion.
